Registration Fee

- The Registration Fee is a portion of the camp fee that is set aside for the express purpose of holding your reservation. A separate registration payment is needed for each session.
- Please use a separate form for each camper (feel free to duplicate form) or register on-line.
- Please mail the Registration Form with the Registration Payment to the camp office. You will receive a letter or email from Phantom Ranch confirming camper registration.
- The registration fee for all sessions is \$75.00.

Camper Fee

The Camper Fee is the main cost of the session, and is stated in our pricing chart. This fee varies for each session, so check the rates for each accordingly. The Camper Fee and Optional Fees are due upon arrival at the Ranch for your session. Avoid long lines at camper check-in and pay your entire Camper Fee and Optional Fees in advance. The following discounts are available.

Large Family Discount

For families, who send more than two children from the same immediate family, there will be a \$50.00 discount on your third and subsequent children. Please note that the full Registration Fee is required for all campers per session. Other conditions may apply.

Pastor and Missionary Discount

Campers whose parents are pastors, full-time missionaries, or full-time Christian camp workers are granted a 50% discount on the camper fee of Classic Camps, and Horsemanship Camps, and a 25% discount on the camper fee of off grounds trips.

No other discounts apply when using this discount. In order to receive this discount, a letter describing ministry affiliation on ministry letterhead must accompany Registration Form; we do not hold letters from year to year. Other conditions may apply.

Bring a Friend

Campers who bring a **new friend** to the session they attend will receive a \$10.00 credit at the Canteen. Just refer someone who is a **first-time attendee** to the summer camp that you will attend at PRBC and this fabulous deal is yours. There is no limit to the number of referrals a camper can bring to their session. Credit is applied after camper check-in, first day of camp.
